- Zero Food Miles (No transportation distance for food)
- Zero Kilometer Food (Food sourced from the immediate surroundings)
- Zero Food Loss (No loss of edible food during production and distribution)
- Zero Food Waste Restaurants (Restaurants that generate no food waste)

- Zero Waste: Products designed to minimize waste and promote sustainability
- Zero Emissions in Supply Chains: No greenhouse gas emissions throughout the supply chain
- Zero Waste in Food Production: No waste generated during food manufacturing and processing
- Zero Packaging: Package-free products
- Zero Impact Packaging: Packaging with no environmental footprint
- Zero Water Waste: No unnecessary water usage
- Zero Water Pollution: No contamination of water sources

- Zero Additives: Foods without artificial additives or preservatives
- Zero GMO: Foods that contain no genetically modified organisms
- Zero Chemical Additives: No chemical additives used in food products
- Zero Palm Oil: Products made without palm oil
- Zero Meat: Meat-free products
- Zero Dairy: Dairy-free products
- Zero Artificial Sweeteners: No artificial sweeteners used
- Zero Calorie: Products containing no or extremely few calories
- Zero Sugar: Foods and beverages with no added sugar, often sweetened with alternatives
- Zero Fat: Fat-free or extremely low-fat products
- Zero Carb: Foods with very low or no carbohydrate content
- Zero Alcohol: Non-alcoholic beverages that mimic traditional alcoholic drinks
- Zero Lactose: Dairy products or alternatives that are lactose-free

- Zero Carbon Farming: Carbon-neutral agriculture
- Zero Emissions Agriculture: Agriculture with no greenhouse gas emissions
- Zero Deforestation for Agriculture: No deforestation caused by agricultural practices
- Zero Soil Degradation: No deterioration of soil quality or fertility
- Zero Biodiversity Loss: No loss of species or ecosystems
- Zero Pesticides: Products grown without the use of pesticides
- Zero Chemical Fertilizers: No chemical fertilizers used in cultivation
- Zero Overfishing: No depletion of fish stocks due to excessive fishing
- Zero Animal Exploitation: No exploitation of animals, e.g., through bio-vegan farming practices
