



## STAND CONSTRUCTION APPROVAL INFORMATION SHEET

## IMPORTANT STAND DESIGN INFORMATION

- → The closed part of the aisle side may not exceed 30%, a single wall should not be longer than 5m at a time. These walls must be graphically designed or broken up by the installation of transparent showcases, niches, displays etc.
- → The rear sides of stands over 2.50m high that border on neighboring stands must be kept neutral. (white wall, joint-free and without commercial statements)
- → The <u>Technical Guidelines</u> of Messe Berlin apply
- → Approval of stand construction plans in accordance with Technical Guidelines 4.2

## STAND CONSTRUCTION APPROVAL - MESSE BERLIN

The following stand construction configurations require separate approval from Messe Berlin. Please note that the complete stand construction documents must be submitted by the deadline. Approval is required for:

- → Stand height over 5.00 m
- → LED walls integrated in stand construction (wider than 4.00 m or higher than 2.00 m)
- → Closed ceilings with an area over 30 m<sup>2</sup>
- → Complex suspensions (e.g., wooden structures, textile decorations)
- → Stands with a footprint over 100 m<sup>2</sup>
- → Vehicles inside of exhibition halls
- → Obstruction of emergency exits

## ENGINEERING INSPECTIONS & STAND APPROVAL - MESSE BERLIN

Certain construction measures require inspection by an engineering firm and approval by Messe Berlin. All relevant documents must be submitted by the deadline. Approval is required for:

- → Multi-story buildings, mobile stands, outdoor stands, and special constructions
- → Walkable grandstands and platforms higher than 0.20 m
- → Freestanding scaffolding and advertising structures with a height of over 5.00 m

Deadline for submitting static calculations and stand construction documents: no later than November 25, 2025
